Scholarship Guidelines

Selection will be based on the following criteria:

1. Scholarship candidate intends to pursue a career in Engineering/Architecture or related fields.
2. Scholarship candidate must be an undergraduate student or graduate student, in good standing, currently enrolled for at least 12 hours for Undergraduate Program and 9 hours for Graduate Program in the College of Engineering/Architecture at a University.
3. Scholarship candidate shall be enrolled in an A.B.E.T. accredited Engineering/Architecture curriculum.
4. Scholarship candidate shall be a student of a university within the Greater Houston Metropolitan Area or affiliated to universities within the Greater Houston Area.
5. Scholarship prospect will demonstrate financial need and will have applied for scholarship consideration with the University.
6. Scholarship candidate must have and maintain a grade point average of at least 3.0/4.0.
7. Scholarship candidate must be involved in extracurricular activities.
8. Scholarship candidate must be a citizen/resident alien of the United States. Students currently on Non-Immigrant Visas (F-1, H-4 etc.) may also apply.
9. Scholarship candidate must be an Indo-American, Indian or must have an Indian heritage.

All applications must be submitted to ASIE by September 19, 2008.

A college transcript shall be attached to the application to illustrate course of studies.

A copy of the financial aid and/or grant application, if any submitted, shall be attached to illustrate requirements of item 5 above.

Current scholarship recipient may reapply.

A. S. I. E. will pay funds to the University. Funds may be used to cover expenses for tuition, books, fees, or supplies.
